## **The 5<sup>th</sup> grade team**

**Pencil pouch 1:** (Everyday classroom supplies)

- 2 blue ink pens
- 2 red correcting pens
- 10 Sharp pencils
- 2 Highlighters
- 1 3X3 post it pad
- 1 pink pearl eraser

**Pencil pouch 2:** (Art supplies for use in classroom)

- 1 marker set
- 1 glue stick
- 1 clear tape
- 1 small scissors
- 1 colored pencil set
- 2 sharpie markers

**Extras (Keep in zip lock bag in locker):**

- 40 pencils
- 5 index card packs
- 1 glue stick
- Earbuds-in a separate zip lock with name on it

**Three-Ring Binder (3 in) :**

- Assignment notebook goes in front.
- Put in 6 laminated, 3-hole punched, pocket folders.
- Write **HOMEWORK** on 1st folder, **MATH** on 2<sup>nd</sup> folder, **SOCIAL STUDIES** on 3<sup>rd</sup> folder, **SCIENCE** on 4<sup>th</sup> folder, **ENGLISH** on the 5<sup>th</sup> folder and **READING** on the 6<sup>th</sup> folder.
- Open one pack of loose leaf paper. Put about 20 pieces in the back of the binder. Keep the rest of the pack in your locker.

**Composition Notebooks**

1. Label one Social Studies.
2. Label the other one Reading

- 1 box tissue
