Fox Point Bayside School District has been inspected for asbestos containing building materials. Our management plan has been submitted to the State of Wisconsin for review in compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Awareness Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR that went into effect in 1987. EMC Consultants has been contracted to perform the required 3-year inspection and to insure compliance with EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) regulations.

The management plan is available for inspection in the Facility Services Department during normal business hours. Due to the size and complexity of the document, you may require the assistance of a staff person familiar with the plan during your examination of the document in our office.

Copies of the plan or parts of the plan may be requested in writing and will be made available within 30 days upon receipt of the request. A fee for labor and duplication will be charged and must be paid in advance.

All asbestos abatement to date has been done safely and successfully according to standards set by the EPA. A mandatory six-month periodic surveillance will be performed by EMC Consultants as well as a three-year cyclical inspection as required by law.
