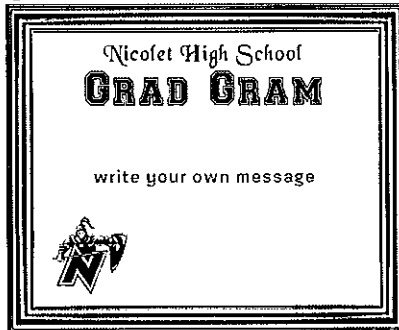

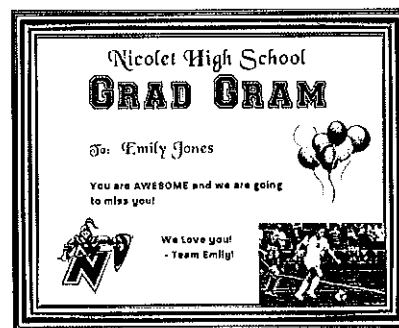

Sample *Do It Yourself* Grad Gram **BEFORE:**

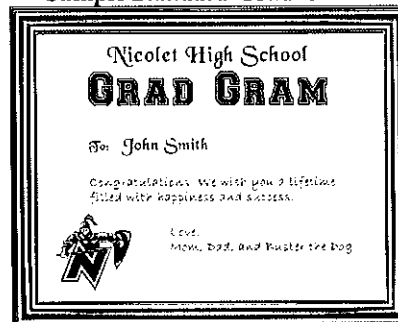


Sample *Do It Yourself* Grad Gram **AFTER:**
