

# Frank C. Worrell



## **“Did I tell you my child is gifted?” “How do you know? What can you do?”**

A native of Trinidad and Tobago, **Frank C. Worrell** received a BA and a Masters in Psychology at the University of Western Ontario and a Ph.D. in School and Educational Psychology at the University of California, Berkeley. Currently, he is a Professor in the Graduate School of Education at the University of California, Berkeley, where he serves as Director of the School Psychology program, Faculty Director of the Academic Talent Development Program, and Faculty Director of the California College Preparatory Academy. His areas of expertise include academic talent development/gifted education, at-risk youth, scale development and validation, teacher effectiveness, and the translation of psychological research findings into school-based practice.

A member of the editorial boards of several journals, Dr. Worrell is Editor of *Review of Educational Research* through 2016 and also serves on committees of several professional associations, including the American Psychological Association (APA), the American Educational Research Association, and the National Association for Gifted Children. He also served as a Council Representative for the School Psychology Division of APA from 2010 – 2015. In 2011, Dr. Worrell received a Presidential citation from the American Psychological Association as well as the Chancellor’s Award for Advancing Institutional Excellence from UC Berkeley. He was one of two recipients of the 2013 Distinguished Scholar Award from the National Association for Gifted Children, and a co-winner in 2015 of the Distinguished Contributions to Research Award from the Division 45 of APA.
