Board Update/Board Briefs

The School Board met for the Regular October Meeting on October 19, 2015

- The Board approved past minutes from Committee and Regular Board meetings.
- The Stormonth Earth Ambassadors and advisor Ms. Patty Stark made a presentation to the Board. They were presented with FPBS Pride certificates.
- English Language Learner teacher Amy Melik presented information on serving on the National Teaching of Tolerance Committee.
- Dr. Galster and middle school teacher Mrs. Erin Miller presented information on the goals and initiatives of Bayside Middle School for the year.
- Each administrator gave a brief report regarding the building or department they lead.

Action Items

1. The Board approved the check register for September.
2. The Board approved the administration recommendation to add a part-time Special Education Instructional Aide to the staffing plan.
3. The Board approved the first reading of 63 policies that were recommended due to State and Federal charges and recommendations from NEO/A, the policy consultants. The second reading will be acted on November 16th.
4. The Board approved changing the parent-teacher conferences scheduled for February 10th to February 24th.
5. The Board approved changing the January 18th Board meeting date to January 19th.
6. The Board approved the proposed Tax Levy as presented at the Annual Meeting and approved by residents on September 21st.
7. The Board approved the Request for Proposal Documents and Procedures for the sale of the Dunwood Property that is owned by the District but currently not housing District programs.

The next Committee of the Whole meeting is scheduled for November 2nd at 7:00 pm in the District office. The next Regular School Board meeting is scheduled for November 16th at 7:00 pm in the Board Room located in the Stormonth building.

Update for Bayside Middle School



October is marked by hard work by both students and staff. The pace of things really picks-up moving from September into October and we are proud of everything that is happening. Some notable events include:

- Fall MAP testing just ended and students are preparing to set growth goals in Math, Reading and English/Language Arts for this first half of the school year.
- Grade level outdoor experiential field trips have enjoyed great weather!
- Soccer and Cross Country teams have been big winners this season!
- Our teaching staff are setting learning targets for our students and developing professional learning goals from themselves, one of which will focus upon instructional technology integration. This is part of Wisconsin's Educator Effectiveness program.
- We had our first 5th & 6th grades Bayside Activity Night on Friday evening, October 9th, and 150 students attended and had a wonderful time!
- We have put our 100 new Chromebooks into circulation, bringing our total to roughly 250 Chromebook devices in the hands of our students. We still maintain our PC labs and one Mac lab as well so our students are getting great exposure to various technology platforms.

(AMLE stands for "Association for Middle Level Education" - used to be "Nat'l Association of Middle Schools")

- Students have moved into the first rotation of our 30 minute Flex period which meets 3-4 times weekly. Roughly 19% of our students are receiving interventions and support in reading, math, writing and organizational skills, while the remaining 80%+ are receiving enrichment in science, social studies, math, art, personal finance, sustained silent reading, writing and advanced literature studies.
- Lastly, our first evacuation and reunification drill, conducted in collaboration with the police departments of Fox Point and Bayside and Riteway Bus Company, was a very successful drill. While we do not enjoy the reasons for having to practice such drills, it is certainly important in today's world to be vigilant and prepared in the event of a true emergency where off-site reunification with students and parents would be necessary.
