

Fox Point-Bayside Public Notification of Nondiscrimination Policy

It is the policy of the Fox Point-Bayside School District that no person shall, on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, medical condition or disease, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program, courses or activity or employment. This policy also prohibits discrimination as defined by Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1972, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. The district encourages informal resolution of complaints under this policy. Any student, parent/guardian, resident, or employee of the School District complaining of discrimination on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap in school programs or activities shall report the complaint, in writing to the District Administrator or the Director of Teaching, Learning and Special Programs.
