- Online event registration will open on Monday, November 14, 2016, at 8:00 AM.
- Event day check-in will run from 7:30 - 8 AM in the Holy Family Cafeteria, located at 4849 N. Wildwood Ave.
- Free parking is available on the street or in the parking lot opposite the school on Wildwood Ave.
- Opening ceremony begins at 8:00am, Participants will leave the cafeteria at 8:15am to start the school classroom programs.
- Courses are taught by industry experts, teachers, and Boy Scout Leaders who will take Scouts through each badge requirement.
- Many, **but not all**, of the badge requirements will be completed at the **STEM FAIR**. A list of requirements needed to be completed at home, will be provided to each participant.
