



## Pond Ecology and Canoeing

**Who:** Gifted kids enrolled in PAGE member school districts.\*

**What:** Explore animal and aquatic adaptations along the shore of the Washington Park Lagoon. Students will collect macro-invertebrates, explore their adaptations, and learn about their relationship to the environment. In addition, students will learn basic canoe skills and explore the pond ecosystem by canoe.
