Capitol ceremony celebrates 2017-18 Wisconsin Title I Schools of Recognition

MADISON — State Superintendent Tony Evers praised **Stormonth Elementary School** for being among 135 schools in the state that received Wisconsin Title I School of Recognition honors for the 2017-18 school year during a special May 21 ceremony at the State Capitol in Madison.
