We are excited to share another update regarding our search for the next Superintendent of the Fox Point-Bayside School District.

For the past two months, in partnership with the <u>Wisconsin Association of School Boards</u> (WASB), the Board has led a collaborative and thorough search process to identify our district's next superintendent. After developing the <u>Superintendent Profile</u> based on outcomes from stakeholder survey results and focus groups, we posted the position, which was open from February 4 to February 25. We received 17 applications, which were thoroughly reviewed, and conducted interviews with standout candidates.

• **Michael Weaver** - Assistant Superintendent at Maple Dale-Indian Hill School District The finalists will visit our schools on March 18 to tour the buildings, meet with administrators, and participate in staff and community listening sessions and closed session interviews with the School Board.

Staff are encouraged to attend the listening sessions for the finalists from 5:30 - 7:30 p.m. in the Bayside Band Room (141). Attendees will have the opportunity to hear from these candidates as they answer predetermined questions submitted by staff and community members. The listening sessions will be moderated by a district facilitator. Following the sessions, staff and the community will share their feedback with the Board via a QR Code linked to a Google Form (or a written survey upon request).

If you are unable to attend the staff sessions, you are more than welcome to attend the community sessions from 6:15 p.m. to 8:15 p.m. in the Bayside Library.
