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SURVEY SAYS...

A long-term vision for the success of our schools and community guides every decision we make. That's why, in November 2025, **all Fox Point-Bayside households received a community survey seeking input on the programs, services and resources that matter most to you.**

Thanks to your participation, **we collected nearly 400 responses** on questions related to each pillar of the Framework for Our Future strategic plan to help us understand what our schools are doing well, where we need to improve and where we should focus our efforts over the next five years.

The results affirm what we see and feel every day. Community members expressed exceptionally strong confidence in the quality and value of our schools. That level of trust is not something we take lightly. **It reflects the collective efforts of our staff, students, families and community partners.**

Survey responses also showed **strong affirmation across all five strategic pillars**, reinforcing that the priorities identified in the strategic plan continue to reflect community values and expectations.

HERE ARE SOME KEY SURVEY TAKEAWAYS THAT WILL SHAPE THE NEXT VERSION OF THE FRAMEWORK FOR OUR FUTURE STRATEGIC PLAN.

PILLAR 1: ENGAGING ACADEMIC CURIOSITY

95%+ | agree or strongly agree that the district demonstrates **exceptional confidence** in teaching quality, high expectations and student growth.

PILLAR 2: FISCAL & FACILITIES STEWARDSHIP

98% | agree or strongly agree that our schools are safe, clean and well-maintained. **80%** | agree or strongly agree that the district clearly communicates its budget situation and challenges.

Responses indicated strong community support for funding priorities that sustain our schools as the district nears the end of its current operational referendum, which is set to expire following the 2026-27 school year.

This input will guide **ongoing conversations and long-range planning for the district's financial sustainability**, ensuring we can continue to provide high-quality programs, services and staffing for students.

In 2021, we began a comprehensive process with our teachers, staff and community to develop a strategic plan that would guide our district for the next five years.
