SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM TIMES

The FPBS Summer Pathways will run two sessions of summer school opportunities where students may participate in session one only, session two only, or both sessions! Children are welcome to repeat a course they took last summer, but course content will be similar to the current offerings. Teachers will use the same class content for both session one and session two. Please be mindful of this when making your child's selection.

- **Session 1:** Monday through Friday, June 24-June 28
& Monday through Wednesday July 1-3 2019 8:00am-11:55am
- **Session 2:** Monday through Friday, July 8-July 19, 2019 8:00am-11:55am

Class Period 1: 8:00am-8:55am

Class Period 2: 9:00am-9:55am

Class Period 3: 10:00am-10:55am

Class Period 4: 11:00am-11:55am

Each child may enroll in four (4), fifty-five minute classes per day based on course availability. *Please note that the transitional courses (Fired up for First Grade, Bayside Mentors, and Movin' to Middle School) run for two consecutive class periods. **You will be asked to pick alternative class choices when you register, in case your first choice is no longer available.**

ELIGIBILITY

Any student currently enrolled in public, private or parochial school having completed grades K-7 is eligible to participate.

DISTRICT STATUS

A resident student is any student who currently attends Stormonth Elementary School or Bayside Middle School or who lives within the Fox-Point Bayside School District boundaries. Students who do not live in the district may enroll if room permits and upon payment of program fees as listed.

PROGRAM FEES

Resident Students (completed) Grades K – 7	See individual course descriptions for material fees.
Non-Resident Students	\$150 per student per session plus individual course fee.

Full payment of course fees, plus any additional materials fees, **must** be submitted prior to the start of the Summer School Program on June 24th, 2019. Summer School Program fees should be paid online using your Infinite Campus Portal account; for families who do not attend FPBS schools during the current school year please contact Mindy Makinster at mmakinster@foxbay.org. Fees will be invoiced with your course schedule confirmation.

Fees will not be prorated due to absence or refunded due to withdrawal from the program.

REGISTRATION

Registration booklet will be available for review on February 15, 2019. An electronic copy of the registration form will be sent home to families on Friday, February 15, 2019. **Online registration will open March 1st.** Hard copies of the course descriptions will be distributed at parent teacher conferences.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Online registration will close at 4:00 p.m. on Monday March 18, 2019. Courses will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Late registrations will be received after this date only if there are seats available in the class and a \$5 late fee per course will be assessed. Please note, you will be asked to define alternate course choices, should your choice be unavailable.

CONFIRMATION OF COURSES AND SCHEDULE

You will receive confirmation of your child's schedule by no later than Friday, May 3, 2019. You will receive a schedule and an invoice for course fees at this time.

ATTENDANCE

All students enrolled in the Summer Education Program are expected to attend classes on a regular basis. Please contact the Stormonth Summer School Office (414-247-4103) to report an absence.

FPBS SUMMER PATHWAYS PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Course Descriptions- Specific Grade Levels

REMINDER: Register for courses based on the grade your child will be going into.

Bayside Mentors - Eligible: students currently attending 7th grade, going into 8th grade (2 class periods)

Wanted: Compassionate students who are interested in being part of the 8th Student Mentor Team. By participating in this session, you will learn the many facets of becoming an 8th grade mentor, such as helping other students work through conflict, giving tours of the building, assisting 5th graders with adjusting to middle school, and being ready to take a leadership role in your last year at Bayside. Character building activities will be an important and meaningful part of this training. To participate, please request an application and teacher recommendation form from Mrs. James.

Fired up for First Grade - Eligible: students currently attending K5 programs, going into 1st grade

Wanted: students who are making the transition from kindergarten to first grade in the fall. Students will work to reinforce the core concepts and basic skills learned throughout kindergarten that will help them succeed in first grade! In literacy students will participate in a variety of activities to help bolster their phonics skills, review and solidify sight word recognition, and prepare them for first grade reader's and writer's workshop. In math students will practice counting skills, addition and subtraction strategies, and work with story problems. We will also get creative and our hands dirty with some fun and interactive arts and crafts projects!

Movin' to Middle School - Eligible: students currently attending 4th grade, going into 5th grade (2 class periods)

Want to get a jump on your first year at Bayside? Interested in learning the best ways to get around the middle school, manage your homework load, or open your locker? Join us for Movin' to Middle School to learn how to be successful during your first year at Bayside through participation in fun activities, such as a Bayside scavenger hunt. From study skills to hall traffic patterns, students will come away from this session with valuable knowledge and skills to help them be successful Bayside 5th graders! Course Descriptions for Students entering Grades 1-8 in the Fall of 2019

All A'Board (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Love to play board games? Want to strengthen your critical thinking skills and strategy development? Choose from a variety of different board games, relax and build a LEGO village, or compete with others to make the best words in Scrabble. Spend your Monopoly money and become the owner of real estate, railroads and utilities. Be sure to pay the taxes or you will pay the consequences. Use your skills to be a winner with a variety of classroom games or bring a favorite to share. Puzzles and games give our brains a boost! Please feel free to bring your own board game, as well.

Astounding Artists (\$5 fee) (\$5) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Students will learn kid-friendly dance routines based on original Zumba® music and choreography. They will have the opportunity to engage in games and cultural activities to demonstrate key elements of teamwork, leadership, focus, coordination, self-confidence, and creativity. Come express your creative energies while learning about different artists and applying their techniques to your creation. Learn different painting and drawing techniques and be prepared to get messy! Students will need to bring an art smock or old t-shirt.

Bon Voyage (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

This is a class where students will explore cities around the world through video, games art and food. Sydney Australia, Phuket, Thailand Naples, Italy and Paris France are just a few of our destinations. Students will fill in passports, drawing flags of countries, journal about what they learned on their voyages.

Building Stories with Legos (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Bring your stories to life with Lego's! This course takes a hands-on approach to narrative writing, using Lego's story-starter kits as inspiration. Students will explore the writing process and stretch their imaginations to create stop-motion stories told through film. This class puts a new spin on the good old-fashioned game of make-believe.

Chess for Champs (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Whether you love chess or have never played it before, this is the class for you! This class helps you understand and learn the game of chess. Learn about the pieces, moves, and strategies used in the ever-popular game of chess. Who knows? You may have what it takes to be a chess champ!

Circuit Training (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Discover your love of running by participating in this highly active walking/running club over the summer. This summer class offers students of all ages the opportunity to engage in regular physical activity each day while having fun! Students will partake in running adventures to build endurance and get them moving toward healthy activity levels. Please have your student wear tennis shoes and bring a water bottle.

Coding and Computer Science (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 4-8

Students will spend time working on various coding and computer science activities. Students will work to program a variety of robotic devices and learn ways to problem solve and think critically.

Cooking and Reading Around the World (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3

Would you like to learn about food from a particular region or country? This is your opportunity to choose a country you would like to learn more about, create a Google slideshow about that country and then learn how to cook a traditional recipe from that particular region/country. Fiction and Non-fiction resources will be used for reading and learning about the different areas of interest.

Disc Games (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Students will work through a skill progression to develop frisbee throwing and catching capabilities. Students will then apply their skills in multiple games from Disc Golf, Disc Bowling, Disc Bocce, Disc Baseball and Ultimate Frisbee. Frisbees will be provided, but feel free to bring your own!

From Notebook to Short Film (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Students will work to develop a Short Film. Students will learn about views on subject matter, character development, empathetic traits, authenticity of script, character flaws, lessons learned, inciting incidents and plot twists, and character secrets and best time to reveal them. Students will spend the first couple of sessions developing the script and then the last sessions producing their short film with iPad and iMovie. Technology lessons will include transitions, camera Point of View, effects, sound, video editing and publishing of film. The last day will be a Red Carpet final showing with parent invitations.

History Fun (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Would you like to explore your favorite history topics? Would you like to play fun, interactive history games? Would you like to use Google Expedition Virtual Reality Goggles to explore different areas of history and the world? Would you like to create your own Google Expedition? This course will have students investigate and explore their favorite history topics and create cool ways to share their findings. Students will play different social Studies related games online or by gameboard. Students will interact with different Social Studies topics through games and Google Expedition Virtual Reality. Students will also create their own Virtual Reality tour on an area of interest! Students will have fun with History in this class!

Jewelry Making (\$10 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Interested in creating your own masterpieces of unique jewelry? This is the class for you where you will get to bead or string your way to unique bracelets, necklaces, rings, earrings, or anklets. Create customized, stylish jewelry ready for you and your friends to wear! Be your own jewelry designer where you can choose your own colors to make one-of-a-kind pieces! You can make simple bead necklaces and bracelets, Elsa inspired necklaces, super cute Pony beaded necklaces, and bracelets out of T-shirts. Grades 4-5 not only will we bead bracelets and necklaces but we will also make wooden bracelets out of Popsicle sticks, splattered paint pendants and friendship bracelets. Grades 6-8 will also try their hand at macrame bracelets. Come join us and let your creativity run wild!

Kid Cuisine(\$10 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

This class is designed for those who love to make food! Students will incorporate their writing skills into writing recipes. Learning about food groups, and measuring all while making kid friendly foods and learning about healthy snacks. Everyone gets the opportunity to be a chef!

Makerspace/STEM Challenges (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 4-8

Join us in *the place* for making, collaborating, learning, and sharing - the Makerspace. Use your creativity and science skills to solve problems and engineer designs - all while exploring great books! From a paper airplane cargo challenge to peep catapults and more, you'll be introduced to authentic problems. Take your problem solving and robot skills to the next level as you develop solutions to the "Makerspace Summer Challenges" using Connectors and Dash Robots to accomplish the objectives. Students with curiosity and imagination wanted!

Math Games (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Are you interested in playing games, but secretly learning math? Students may play card games, Sequence Numbers, I Sea 10, Sumoku, Super Genius, Speed, Prime Club, and many more.

Origami Paper Folding (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Impress your family, friends, (and you) with a new skill! Have fun creating magical animals, airplanes, flowers, fish, (and more), with papers, folds, and flips. You will come away with a colorful collection of paper decorations, toys, cards, and gifts!

Painting and Printing from A-Z (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Have you ever painted a picture with Ice...or with a Dinosaur...or even with a Zipper? Come and create some unique pictures with some "everyday" objects! Students will create pictures using everyday objects from A-Z ie apples, bubble wrap, cups, dinosaurs, etc.

Paper Mache Beasties (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Would you believe that you can create small, fun creatures out of newspaper, paper tubes, masking tape, plaster strips, paint, and googly eyes? Find out how with this creative and crafty class.

Readers Theater (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Sink your teeth into summer by creating your own stories and skits based off of your favorite stories or a new story! Develop reading fluency by exploring famous authors and acting out your favorite scenes! Who needs costumes, props, or a set when you have a creative imagination?

Social Thinking and Mindfulness (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Do you ever struggle with knowing what to do in different social situations? They can be complicated, and it may feel impossible to know how to act differently in school, at home, or in a team on the soccer field. This course will explore the "hidden rules" that are the guidelines that help us figure out how to be social in any situation. By the end, you'll have a better idea what to say, or what to do (or not do) when you are with others. Each class session will include a mini-lesson on Mindfulness, **or** maintaining a moment-by-moment awareness of our thoughts, feelings, bodily sensations, and surrounding environment, through a gentle, nurturing lens. ... When we practice **mindfulness**, our thoughts tune into what we're sensing in the present moment rather than rehashing the past or imagining the future.

Sports Frenzy (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Do you love sports? Sports are a great way to build valuable skills that will benefit all facets of life. Sports Frenzy will emphasize teamwork, sportsmanship, and rule-following through competitive team sports. Sports will include basketball, kickball, soccer, and flag-football. It is going to be tons of fun!

Summer Adventures (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3

This course is designed to help students forget the stress of the school year with some good old fashioned fun! Your child will participate in a variety of activities in athletics, the arts, science and games, all while having fun, making friends and creating lifelong memories.

Summer Pathways Press (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Have you always dreamed of being a reporter? Well, here is your chance! Amazing things are happening all around Summer Pathways, and this is your opportunity to help document them! Student reporters will investigate all the fun activities and learning throughout Summer Pathways' courses. Students will conduct interviews, take photos, and write articles to share with an audience through a new publication.

Summer STEM Challenges (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3

Use your creativity and science skills to solve problems and engineer designs - all while exploring great books! From a paper airplane cargo challenge to peep catapults and more, you'll be introduced to authentic problems through children's books then work independently or with others to come up with possible solutions. Science, Technology, Engineering and Math will take center stage as you brainstorm solutions, revise, retest, and reflect on your process. Come have fun AND grow your brain every step of the way!

Super Science (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Students will explore scientific ideas through a variety of fascinating hands-on experiments that help bring the exciting world of science to life. They will learn interesting science facts by experimenting with different materials that react in surprising ways. This course will also give students the opportunity to make and take some experiments.

PE Games (no fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

The focus will be on teamwork, sportsmanship, and safety skills while we will play a wide variety of creative Physical Education games. This adventure of recreational fun will provide plenty of non-stop action for all kids. Please bring a water bottle and wear PE shoes.

Weaving Wonder (\$5 fee) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3 and grades 4-8

Learn all kinds of techniques weaving yarn on a loom. Students will work on a small project such as a keychain to learn the basics and then move on to a larger project. Larger projects include making 1-2 wall weavings (a rectangle first and then a circle if time permits).

Zumba® Kids (\$5) Eligible: students entering grades 4-8

Students will learn kid-friendly dance routines based on original Zumba® music and choreography. They will have the opportunity to engage in games and cultural activities to demonstrate key elements of teamwork, leadership, focus, coordination, self-confidence, and creativity.

Zumba® Kids Jr (\$5) Eligible: students entering grades 1-3

Students will learn kid-friendly dance routines based on original Zumba® music and choreography. They will have the opportunity to engage in games and cultural activities to demonstrate key elements of teamwork, leadership, focus, coordination, self-confidence, and creativity.
