## 2. District Report (Dr. Jeff Dellutri)

a. At the last Architectural Review Committee, we received permission to accept bids for the new school. Major bids are coming in on April 18. We will be meeting with the committee and Bayside residents again on May 1 to hopefully finalize the plans for the new school.
b. Stormonth construction projects will start this summer, so summer school classes will be at Bayside
c. The new Bayside Middle School will have a dedicated Computer Science classroom. We are considering starting a computer science elective, starting in 5th or 6th grade
d. Financial Literacy month: Waterstone bank is putting on a Student-Parent Financial Literacy event on April 20 at 6PM in the Bayside Library
e. Director of Teaching and Learning position: Laura Dahm, who is currently the Director of Elementary Education in the Kettle Moraine school district, has been hired for this position. Thirty-three candidates applied, and a team of 16 people helped Dr. Dellutri interview and discern. She will be in our district on Tuesday, April 11t. Many thanks to Dr Danny Westfahl, who has been serving as the interim Director. Dr. Westfahl will be leaving the district.
