#### b. **Teacher Appreciation Week:** Went well

- i. Next year, we really need to have a committee to execute all the events for TAW. Britten recommends 4 roles: (1) Fundraising, Daily "free" family activities and Communications. (2) Teacher Gifts / Gift Cards / Raffle (3) Teachers' Lounge (decorations, stocking, maintaining) (4) Other meals / gifts (e.g. Breuggers, Corner Bakery, Costco Breakfast, Papa John's).
- ii. Britten also feels that we need a better Communications Plan and more daily updates out to families on what we do.

- iii. Thank you to Tiffani Rodriguez and the front office staff
- c. 1st and 2nd Grade Kids Night Out: Pirate / Beach themed event was a success; we got positive.
  - i. We budgeted for half of 1st and 2nd grade, guesstimating 150 kids at \$5 = \$750. We came close! 124 signed up. But since we estimated the 150, we didn't quite make our budget, and spent \$119.25 over what we made so we were in the red. However, not bad considering it was our first time doing this!
  - ii. Details:
    - 1. We had 124 kids sign up. Many signed up the week and day of.
    - 2. Total income was \$609.52
    - 3. Total expenses were \$728.77
    - 4. Total kids that were *signed* into the event were 110 (give or take a few here)
    - 5. 62% paid via venmo 38% cash.
    - 6. 54% were 1st graders and 46% 2nd graders.
