2. VP Ways and Means (Nicole Stickler)

- a. RaiseRight: So far, 23 families are signed up, and we have received \$163, mostly in the past three weeks. We are updating the website with marketing materials and will send out an email to encourage signup. We need a RaiseRight chair, so a social media post is coming.
- b. Giving Campaign: \$425 came in through Giving Tuesday. The Family Giving campaign raised \$3,050 for district families in need
- c. Spirit Wear - 2 sales open for Crocs Gibbets, We've made \$325 and sales are increasing. This week we're opening the store for branded swag with 2 different ordering options - traditional sales from Burkhardts. There is also going to be a branded store with ongoing spirit wear sales - t-shirts, hats, tote bags, mugs, etc. This will be handled entirely by the vendor. Allison Wolf is the new chair for Spirit Wear.
- d. Spring Book Fair - The sale will take place the week of April 29 at Long Acre Pavillion, with Scholastic. The goal is \$11,000 in Scholastic Dollars.
- e. Spring Fundraiser - Raise Craze does a fundraiser based on acts of kindness that we might consider. Nicole will have more information in February.
- f. Winter Fun Event - On January 29 (a teacher inservice day), Urban Air Adventure Park in Waukesha will host our Winter Fun Event from 3PM until 8PM. A portion of the sales will be donated to us.
- g. Cupcake Run Update - Saturday May 18 at Stormonth, the permit is being procured and volunteers are being signed up this week.

- b. A survey was sent to district families about who needs summer childcare and also advertising district summer programs. 124 ppl responded to the survey, 77 families need after care in the end of May / first week of June, then the first week in September about 82 families need care.
