- ★ 4th graders will be assigned Bayside 7th Grade Buddies and will exchange letters about their Bayside experience.
- ★ Late April Parents will receive 5th grade elective information for choosing a World Language, along with their choice of Performing Arts class(es), should they decide to participate.
- ★ May 9th from 7 PM to 9 PM at Bayside 4th graders are invited to join the 5th grade at BAN (Bayside Activity Night). There will be a DJ with music, sports, and games for students to play along with several prizes available to win.
