- Dress your best: Students are encouraged to dress up (jackets and ties; nice sweater, blouse or a dress). No hoodies or athletic clothing please. (We will have some extra dress clothes on hand just in case.) Note that some pictures will be a ¾ pose, not just a headshot, so dress appropriately. Students can bring casual clothes to change into afterwards.
