SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM TIMES

The FPBS Summer Pathways program will run for four weeks this summer. There are opportunities where students may participate in session 1 only, session 2 only, but both sessions are preferred! Children are welcome to repeat a course they took in previous summers, but course content will be similar to the current offerings. Your child will take 4 different classes that will last the full 2 weeks of each session. Please be mindful of this when making your child's selection. Some classes have special grade level content and are only offered to specific grades. Again, please read course descriptions carefully.

- After Care: EMPOW3R Sports will run camp as wrap care this year. Camp will begin each day at 12:00 when Summer Pathways dismisses and will run until 4:30PM. Each student may enroll in four (4), fifty-five minute IN PERSON classes per day based on course availability. When you register for classes, if you don't see the course you are looking for, it is no longer available. This is an indication that that course is at capacity. Alternate classes are no longer a requirement. Therefore, you will need to plan accordingly.

ELIGIBILITY/DISTRICT STATUS

Any resident student, who lives within the Fox-Point Bayside School District boundaries, currently enrolled in public, private or parochial school currently in grades K4-7 are eligible to participate. *We are not accepting non-district resident enrollment. If your student does not currently attend school in the Fox Point-Bayside School District, but you live in the district, please email ICHelp@foxbay.org with your address and an email will be sent with directions.

REGISTRATION

Program Fees:

See individual course descriptions for material fees.

NEW THIS YEAR: You will NOT be asked to pay for classes until after classes have been confirmed. This new policy allows the Summer Pathways team time to adjust classes as needed, after registration. Final schedules will be emailed to families the week of May 19th. You will be required to pay in full AFTER May 19th. All dues will be required to be paid in full



on or before Monday, June 6, 2025. No students may attend Summer Pathways until all fees have been paid. Once paid, fees will not be prorated due to absence or refunded due to withdrawal from the program.

Registration Opens:

Online registration will open Monday, March 17, 2025 at 4:00PM. Registration for courses will be based on the grade your child is currently in for the 2024-25 school year. Please read the descriptions carefully before completing the course registration through the IC portal link below. Be mindful of the grade bands. Most courses are offered to K5-2, 3-4 and 5-7 grade bands, but read carefully as some courses offered will incorporate grade levels beyond these particular bands.

Summer Pathways Online Registration Instructions

Registration Closes:

Online registration will close at Midnight on Friday, April 4, 2025. Courses will be filled automatically, based on course availability. Please note, you will NOT be asked to select alternate course choices this year. When registering, the courses will not appear if the course is at maximum capacity. Please plan accordingly! Last year, most classes were filled on the day that registration opened. Again, with high registration traffic, many classes close quickly. Therefore, waiting until April 4th is highly discouraged. We are not accepting non-district resident enrollment this year. If your student does not currently attend school in the Fox Point-Bayside School District, but you live in the district, please email ICHelp@foxbay.org with your address and an email will be sent with directions.

CONFIRMATION OF COURSES AND SCHEDULE

NOTE: If you accidentally register your child(ren) for more than one class in an hour, the Summer Pathways staff will choose one of the picked classes that has available seats. You will receive a finalized schedule for Summer Pathways the week of Monday, May 19, 2025.

ATTENDANCE

All students enrolled in the Summer Pathways program are expected to attend classes every day of the entire session that they are enrolled in. If a child will not be present for a day, families must report their attendance through the Infinite Campus Parent app. Directions and more information about this process will be provided to parents in May.

PROGRAM POLICIES

The Fox Point-Bayside School District Summer Pathways program utilizes all school district rules and policies, including behavior, conduct, and cell phone use. These guidelines must be maintained to support effective programming. In addition, The Fox Point-Bayside School District utilizes the same computer/internet policies for summer school, as the school year. You can find those policies on the district webpage.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is not provided for Summer Pathways. Parent carpools are strongly encouraged and have proven to be very effective in reducing traffic congestion. A shuttle bus transportation will be provided for students attending Summer Pathways classes at Bayside and



Stormonth. Most classes will be held at Stormonth School!

DROP OFF and PICK UP

Please drop off all students in the back parking lot of Stormonth School. Enter the parking lot through the SOUTH driveway entrance pull up as far as you can along the sidewalk no earlier than 7:50 am. Please make sure students are exiting on the passenger side of the car and step onto the sidewalk. When leaving, you will continue along the curb driving north and exit using the north end of the parking lot. If you arrive after 8:05 or if there is no Summer Pathways staff visible at drop off, please pull around to the front entrance and bring them to the office for check in.

Pick up will start SHARPLY at 11:55 at Stormonth School or Bayside Middle School if HR4 ends there. Please be mindful of the summer staff and their time by arranging for timely pick up. CAR PICK UP will take place the same as drop off.

WALK UP PICK ups will meet at the bike racks in front of Stormonth on the north end of the building.

LATE PICK UPS will need to report to the front office, using the main entrance.

FPBS SUMMER PATHWAYS PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

GRID OF CLASSES to Help With Planning Worksheet

Here you will find what classes are offered, what hour and what session for what grade level.

REMINDER: Register for courses based on your child's **CURRENT** grade! (2024/25 school year)

Adventures In Cooking (\$15 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 3-7

Learn about the foods, cultures, and mealtime traditions of countries around the world. We'll be preparing and tasting traditional dishes and exploring culture with the help of short stories, nonfiction texts, music, and short films.

Building Stories with Legos: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Bring your stories to life with Legos! This course takes a hands-on approach to narrative writing, using Lego's story-starter kits as inspiration. Students will explore the writing process and stretch their imaginations to create stop-motion stories told through film. This class puts a new spin on the good old-fashioned game of make-believe.

Camp SEL: Wellness Warriors: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-4

Come to Camp SEL where we'll explore mindfulness, gratitude, wellness, thoughtfulness, and friendship through fun hands-on activities, community circles, read-alouds, mindful movement, and mindful tasting! From creating nature mandalas and playing cooperative games, to guided visualizations and mindfulness practices, Wellness Warriors will build their self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship, and responsible decision-making skills. Daily integration of a community Charter, Mood Meter, and Best Self reflections will make a direct connection to the RULER approach to social and emotional learning here in the Fox Point-Bayside School District.

Card Sharks: (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Card games have been a popular pastime for centuries. They take logic, strategy, and focused concentration. Students currently in grades 1-3 learn Uno, spoons, speed, war, and Old Maid. Students currently in grades 4-7 learn, practice and play classic card games like cribbage, golf and 99. Just one deck of cards provides endless opportunities. Do you have what it takes to be a card-shark?



Chess for Champs: (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 2-7

Whether you love chess or have never played it before, this is the class for you! This class helps you understand and learn the game of chess. Learn about the pieces, moves, and strategies used in the ever-popular game of chess. You will also learn how to manage tournament brackets. Who knows? You may have what it takes to be a chess champ!

Crafty Kids: (\$10)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

This course is about all things crafts! Unleash your inner creativity to make many different crafts throughout this session! We will be making different items like slime, bouncy balls, 3D paintings, etc. Please bring an old t-shirt or art smock. Please also bring in a white item (for example: t-shirt, socks, pillow case, bandana, headband, etc) to tie-dye!

Disc Games: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Students will work through a skill progression to develop frisbee throwing and catching capabilities. Students will then apply their skills in multiple games from Disc Golf, Disc Bowling, Disc Bocce, Disc Baseball and Ultimate Frisbee. Frisbees will be provided, but feel free to bring your own!

Editor's Corner-Summer Pathways Press (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 6-7

Step into the role of a newspaper editor this summer! In this exciting course for 6th and 7th graders, students will take on the responsibility of overseeing the creation of the Summer Pathways Press. As editors, they will work together to craft and shape articles, interview key figures, and lead a team of young writers to cover the hottest topics of the Summer Pathways Program. From reporting on new classes to exploring the incredible new school buildings, editors will get hands-on experience in the world of journalism and leadership.

Emoji Pillow Making: (\$10 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 2-7

What better way to express feelings than with emojis? In this class, students will explore the different meanings attached to each emoji, discuss how feelings are conveyed through facial expressions and body language, and create a fun project. Using felt, a pillow will be designed with a student's favorite emoji, or one specially imagined. Various hand sewing stitches such as the running, blanket, or whip stitch will be shown, giving each student a choice in how to finish off the pillow edge.

* Fired Up for First Grade - Literacy: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in K5 ONLY

Are you ready to BLAST off to first grade? This course is designed to support current



kindergarten students who are making the transition to first grade in the fall. Students will work to reinforce foundational skills and knowledge that will set them up for an amazing start in first grade. We will also be adding in fun and meaningful learning in all we do with hands-on activities, games, outdoor time, music, art, and so much more!

In the Reading session, students will participate in learning to help bolster their phonics skills, review and solidify sight word recognition, learn great reading habits, and be involved in all kinds of literacy based fun!

* Fired Up for First Grade - Math: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5 ONLY

Are you ready to BLAST off to first grade? This course is designed to support current kindergarten students who are making the transition to first grade in the fall. Students will work to reinforce foundational skills and knowledge that will set them up for an amazing start in first grade. We will also be adding in fun and meaningful learning in all we do with hands-on activities, games, outdoor time, music, art, and so much more!

In the Math session, students will practice counting skills, addition and subtraction strategies, story problems, number recognition, play math games, and lots more!

Fitness Fun "Movin' and Groovin'": (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Get ready to move, groove, and stay active this summer! In Fitness Fun, kids will tackle exciting obstacle courses, try out different workouts, and challenge themselves in new ways. Whether you love running, jumping, or just being active, this session is packed with fun ways to stay fit and strong. Let's have a blast while getting our bodies moving!

Global Games & Movement: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Students will participate in recess games from around the world.

Healthy Bites - Fuel for fun! (\$10 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-2

Come learn to fuel your busy summer with healthy and yummy snacks! We'll explore how to choose and create delicious foods that feed our souls and fuel our bodies. We'll focus on healthy behaviors like handwashing, etiquette, and keeping ourselves safe in the kitchen. Students will come away with a recipe book of healthy snacks and kitchen confidence!

* Kick Off to K5: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in K4 ONLY (runs 4 consecutive hours)

Special to this class-no other classes are available for K4 students, and K4 students are only eligible for one session, so please pick only session 1 OR 2, but not both.

Get ready for an exciting start to school! This fun and interactive summer class is designed for K4 students approaching K5 next year. The focus will be to build essential skills for kindergarten



success. Through engaging stories, playful learning activities, social-emotional development, and early math concepts, students will gain confidence and enthusiasm for their big year ahead. Join us for a summer of learning, laughter, and new friendships!

Kids Rock Camp: Exploring Rocks, Gems & Other Wonders of the Earth: (\$5)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

In this camp children will learn all about rocks; how they are formed, fossils, caves, art with rocks and more! Each day will include hands-on learning, sharing from your rock collection, rock art, rock tumbling and games. Get ready to "rock" out!

!! Koppa-Holdren Tennis Academy: (\$100 fee)

Fee will be paid directly to Koppa Tennis via email from Sami Holdren

Eligible: Students currently in grades K5-7

Do you want to learn a new, fun sport? Structured tennis lessons with an emphasis on developmental skills, fitness, and fun is a part of Summer Pathways! The newly designed sessions are brought in by the Nicolet head boys and girls tennis coach, Tim Koppa, and a Stormonth teacher/tennis coach, Sami Holdren. The Koppa Family brings over 30 years of tennis experience leading recreation programs and creating champions! Multiple students from the Fox Point Bayside Bay School District that have attended the academy have become varsity players, state qualifiers, North Shore Conference Champions, and a few STATE CHAMPIONS! This program will be offered to students currently in grades K5-7. We encourage kids of all skill levels to join us. Tennis players are encouraged to bring a water bottle, their own racket (rackets will be provided for those who do not have their own), and a good attitude! Classes will run...rain or shine. If it were to rain, students would go inside to gain more knowledge of the sport, scoring, and to improve their mental toughness. The cost of this program will be \$100.00 and the payment will be made via cash or check. Makerspace Magic: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Bring your creativity and sense of wonder as you explore with makerspace materials. Students will be able to build structures with Keva planks, straw connectors, marble runs, and more! Other materials will also be available for students who want to create their own crafty projects.

Masterpiece Makers: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-3

Let's go on a creative adventure! We'll explore a variety of materials and learn new techniques while drawing, painting, sculpting, and more. Bring your imagination and create your own masterpiece.



Mischief & Magic: Harry Potter Inspired: (\$5 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Step into the amazing world of magic where young wizards will be sorted into houses, complete exciting challenges like Triwizard Tasks and take an enchanting spell potions class! Get ready to listen to a Harry Potter read aloud, craft your very own dragon egg, decorate a wand and taste sweet treats from our version of Honeydukes! This class will be an unforgettable journey for every young spell caster!

Mixed Media Magic: (\$5 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 4-7

Get ready to mix it up! Unleash your creativity while exploring a variety of materials. Learn to combine paint, collage, found objects, and more to create artwork that's as unique and wonderful as you are!

* # @ Moving to Middle School: (\$10 T-Shirt fee)

Eligible: students currently in grade 4 ONLY

This class is designed to acclimate 4th grade students to Bayside Middle School. Students will learn their way around the building, how to follow a middle school class schedule, open a locker lock with a combination, and other essential skills to be successful 5th graders at Bayside Middle School. Note: This class is a 2 hour class from 8:00-9:55 or 10:00-11:55.

Musical: The Claw! : (\$10 T-Shirt fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 3-7 (This class will run both session 1 and session 2. Both sessions are required to be in the musical)

Be in a musical and put on a full production for friends and family! This year's Summer Pathways musical will be The Claw!

When an out-of-order claw game suddenly turns back on, all of the toys are ecstatic! Well... all of the toys except for Dot, a terrified stuffed cow. Dot's desperate to hold onto her home and her best friend, Aiden. Can Dot conquer her fear of the unknown with some help from the Flair Bears, Mighty Mutant Power Turtles, Beanie Elders, and the all-knowing Mystical 8-ball?

Origami: (\$5 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 3-7

Unfold the secrets of Japanese paper folding. Learn how to transform a flat piece of paper into 3D treasures. Have fun creating animals, airplanes, flowers, ninja stars, and more with folds and flips. You will take home a colorful collection of decorations, toys, and gifts.

Outdoor Art-ventures: (\$5 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-5

Did you know you can make art with leaves and rocks? Did you know that the Impressionists



were a group of painters that liked to paint outside, right on the spot? In this course we will take our art outside! Painting, drawing, and building art environments will all be explored in this super fun summer class!

Paper Mache: (\$10 fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Would you believe that you can create small, fun creatures out of newspaper, paper tubes, masking tape, paint, and googly eyes? Find out how with this creative and crafty class.

Passion Projects: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 3-7

Ever wonder why school buses don't have seatbelts? or How to raise money for a cause? Ever wonder about your favorite sports teams and games? Learn how reading, research, writing and most of all WONDERING can help. Students will be able to create visuals and models as well to help present and share their findings and ideas. This course will also allow students to explore some different careers of community members (firefighters, police, teachers, business members, government members, etc.) to get a better understanding of the different jobs and make students aware of their communities. Students will also have the opportunity to explore a sports based passion project. Students will get to learn more about their favorite sports and sports superstars! Students will generate "I wonder" questions about different athletes or sports to learn about and research. Then, they will design and create a visual display of their learning. Students will also have the opportunity to explore and create their own games (rules, game boards, etc.) Students will have time to play the games with each other as well.

Passion Projects Junior :(No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-3

We will start creating class by creating some crafts about different things people are passionate about? We will start out the unit by talking about some WI animals and we will create a birdhouse! Afterwards, we will create some passion projects around creating a fun marketplace! Students will create and promote a Lemonade Stand and any other stands based on items they would like to run during Summer Pathways.

PE Games: (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

The focus will be on teamwork, sportsmanship, and safety skills while we will play a wide variety of creative Physical Education games! This adventure of recreational fun will provide plenty of non-stop action for all kids. Please bring a water bottle and wear PE shoes.

@ Pickleball : (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 4-7

Learn this great game that people of all ages can play together at the same time. Play competitively or play socially. Either way, you can play with friends or play with grandparents. Come and learn how to rally with shots of all kinds. Learn how to hit a "smash" shot or perfect a "dink" shot. Discover how to call the score of the game and hopefully you won't ever get



"pickled." There is a place on the court called "the kitchen." You will be taught when you can & cannot go into the kitchen. This game will improve your hand-eye coordination & provide exercise without having to run a lot. Best of all, a good laugh has proven to reduce stress. While playing this game you will enhance your well-being & increase your mood. Beware, this game is addictive! It will provide fun, giggles, and health benefits. Sign up for Pickleball and sharpen your mental keenness as well! All classes will be held in the Bayside gym.

Picture Perfect Press (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 1-7

Ready to tell stories through your camera lens? In this exciting course for young photographers, students will learn how to capture the vibrant energy and exciting moments of the Summer Pathways program. From the buzz of new classes to the awe-inspiring new buildings, photographers will be responsible for documenting the happenings around campus, telling the story of the summer through powerful and dynamic images. Whether you're a beginner or have some photography experience, this course will help you hone your skills and create stunning visuals that will be featured in the summer school newspaper.

Reader's Theater:(No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-5

It's storytime! Readers theater will improve your fluency, comprehension, and expression. Act out your favorite characters with fun stories. With a bit of practice, you'll perform confidently as a team. Who needs costumes and memorization when you have a creative imagination?

Rock Band: Jam, Play & Perform! (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 3-7

Calling all young rockstars! Open to grades 3 and up, this high-energy rock band experience gives students the chance to shred on guitar, groove on bass, rock out on drums, or jam on the keys—all in a real band setting! With a mix of guidance and creative freedom, students will learn awesome songs, develop their skills, and collaborate like true musicians. Whether you're a beginner or already rocking, this class is your ticket to making music, making friends, and making some noise! Some music experience is needed.

Set Design for the musical THE CLAW: (\$10 T-shirt fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 5-7 (Session 2 only)

Build THE CLAW for the Summer Pathways musical! We will need to make a Claw Machine that will fit kids inside, not stuffed animals, plus many more props and costumes. This will be a fun and creative class where you get to bring your imagination to life!

Sportz Frenzy: (No Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Do you love sports? Sports are a great way to build valuable skills that will benefit all facets of life. Sportz Frenzy will emphasize teamwork, sportsmanship, and rule-following through



competitive team sports. Sports will include basketball, kickball, soccer, and flag-football. It is going to be tons of fun! Please bring a water bottle and wear PE shoes.

Summer Pathways Press (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 2-7

Get ready to become a junior journalist this summer! Our newspaper writing class is a hands-on, creative adventure designed for young learners eager to explore the world of storytelling, reporting, and journalism. Throughout this exciting summer school course, students will learn how to write articles, interview peers, interview teachers and cover exciting topics such as the hottest classes offered at Summer Pathways 2025, the fantastic new buildings, and all the amazing things these new spaces bring to our Summer Pathways Program.

Super Science (\$10 Fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Students will explore scientific ideas through a variety of fascinating hands-on experiments that help bring the exciting world of science to life. They will learn interesting science facts by experimenting with different materials that react in surprising ways. This course will also give students the opportunity to make and take some experiments.

Thunder Chorus: Rhythm & Voices: A Global Music Adventure! (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades K5-7

Get ready to sing, drum, and groove in this high-energy musical experience! In this class, singers of all ages will come together to explore songs from around the world, blending powerful choir ensemble vocals with the pulse of drums and percussion instruments. Expect foot-stomping beats, soaring melodies, and rhythms that will shake the walls and stir your soul. Whether you love to sing, drum, or just feel the music, this is your chance to make some noise and have a blast!

TikTok Dancers: (No fee)

Eligible: students currently in grades 2-7
