DEADLINE: APRIL 28, 2023


- Use this link to access the permission and info form: <u>Promotion Permission and</u> Info form
- The Ceremony takes place Wednesday, June 7, 2023 at 6:30pm. Doors open at 6:00pm. All guests must have tickets. 8th grade students do **not n**eed a ticket.
- Each family is allotted five (5) tickets for the ceremony. Your ticket number request is one item in the general Promotion permission form found here. Please indicate the number you will need, especially if it is less than five tickets in case another family can use your extra(s). If your family needs more than 5 tickets, please email Stacy Williams (stacy.paridon@gmail.com). We will work to honor all requests but cannot guarantee.
- Ceremony tickets will begin to be distributed on Friday, May 19th from 3:30pm -6:00pm in the BMS lobby. After May 19th, tickets will continue to be available for pickup in the Health Office during school hours (7:30 AM - 4:00 PM, Monday -Friday).
- Ceremony attire: All students are asked to wear dress attire, such as a collared shirt & tie, dress pants/skirt, dressy top, dress, etc. NO JEANS, SHORTS, SWEATSHIRTS OR LEGGINGS, PLEASE.
- After the ceremony there will be a brief reception for families. Volunteers will be available to take pictures of your graduate and family/friends.
- 8th grade student-only Promotion celebration activities will follow immediately after the ceremony reception.


Online Payment Information

DEADLINE: APRIL 28, 2023

- 1. Log in to your parent portal in Infinite Campus. There is an icon on the right hand side of the Bayside Middle School home page
- 2. Select Fees from the left side menu options. Your 8th grader should appear with an 8th Grade Promotion Fee. Once you click on the blue "add to cart," the payment will be in your cart and you can go to your cart to check out with your payment.
- 3. If you would like to add an optional additional donation to help BMS families for whom fees may be a hardship and to defray other promotion costs:
 - a. Please select "Optional Payments" at the bottom of your fees page which will direct you to a drop down list of optional payments.
 - b. In the middle of that list you will click on "8th Grade Promotion Donation". Click on "Add to Cart"
 - c. When you click on your cart, you can enter the payment for the donation of any amount you would like to donate. This amount will be added to your subtotal and you can continue through the final steps of the payment process. We thank you for considering!

 - Using the link above, please upload ONE baby/toddler photo of your 8th grader to be included in the memory book and promotion slideshow.
 PLEASE name the file using the child's last name, first name.
 TO UPLOAD:
 - Click folder link in this doc
 - Select folder name that appears below link
 - Upload photo to folder
 - Once the photo is in folder, rename it (right click, rename) with a with above guidance
- ★ Over the Years photos folder file name should describe photo
 - Using the link directly above, upload 1-5 additional photos representing your child and other 8th grade classmates (if possible) that you have collected "through the years" from K4-8th grade or from whenever your child joined the district until present. TO UPLOAD:
 - Click folder link in this doc
 - Select folder name that appears below link
 - Upload photo to folder
 - Once the photo is in folder, rename it (right click, rename) with a descriptive name
 - Photos should be from school events, activities or sports to include PTO-sponsored events held at either Stormonth or Bayside. We will not be able to use photos from personal events such as birthday parties, recreational or club sports teams etc. or photos with children from other grade levels or school districts. We want all students to be represented, so please send in photos!
- ★ If you do not have a digital photo, bring the picture(s) into the office. The office staff will scan them and upload them for you. The original photo will be returned to your student to bring home. The finished size of the baby photo will be 2 ½ x 3 ½.
- ★ Portrait selection Your 8th grader's portrait was taken by Network Photography on March 21st at school. You will receive a separate email from Network Photography with instructions on viewing all and selecting your favorite

for use in the 8th Grade Memory Book, the Promotion slideshow and the Class of 2023 composite. You will also have an opportunity to order photos at that time. 8th Grade Promotion – Important Dates

April 14

This is the deadline for <u>baby pictures</u> (file name LASTNAME, FIRSTNAME) and <u>over the years</u> (file name to include names or photo description) to be included in the slideshow, video and memory book. We want all students represented, so please submit a few photos!

This is also the deadline for selecting your favorite photo from Network Photography. That photo was taken on March 21st while the kids were at school. You will receive a separate email from Network Photography when those photos are ready for your review and selection instructions.

April 28

<u>Student info, ticket requests</u> and fees are due by this date. This requires two steps - completion of the Google form (linked above) and online payment via Infinite Campus or a check delivered to the school office. Online payment instructions follow in this packet.

May 19

Requested ceremony tickets will be distributed to parents from 3:30pm-6pm in the BMS lobby on this date. Tickets will also be available for parent pick up in the Health Office *after* May 19th through June 6th during school hours (Monday - Friday, 7:30am - 4:00pm). Tickets cannot be sent home with your student(s) and must be picked up by a parent or guardian.

June 7

Promotion Day!

8:30am ★ Class Breakfast for students only. Immediately following breakfast, 8th graders will go to the gym to rehearse for the promotion ceremony.

11:00am ★ **Dismissal** - 8th grade students will be dismissed at 11:00am, provided they have turned in the permission slip signed by a parent or guardian. There will not be buses for the students; arrangements must be made by the parent or guardian. Students who remain at school will be supervised until 3:30 and will be dismissed at that time per their routine.

6:00pm ★ 8th Graders and families arrive at BMS. Please bring your ceremony tickets with you. Your 8th grade student will **not** need a ticket but family members (*limited to 5*) will. Seating is first come, first served.

6:30pm ★ Promotion Ceremony - Bayside Middle School Gym

7:30pm ★ **Reception** - Families are welcome to stay for a brief reception to take pictures. Volunteers will be available to help take photos.

Following the reception - BMS Cafeteria ★ STUDENTS ONLY will enjoy entertainment, dinner and photos. ALL STUDENTS SHOULD REMAIN IN THEIR PROMOTION ATTIRE; DO NOT BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHES. All students staying for the celebration must remain at school, unless the parent has arranged an early pick-up for their student.

10:00pm ★ Please arrange to **pick up** your child promptly at this time at the doors by the healthroom (main BMS school doors). Students will **not** be permitted to walk home. Thank you!
