HIT RX SUMMER CAMP

This camp will help build foundational skills for both hitting and fielding. During our camp, we will gain an understanding of the players needs for both hitting and fielding through the Hit RX process. This consists of a "diagnosis" phase that allows us to see what a player needs to work on mechanically to improve their hitting and fielding technique. After the "diagnosis" phase, we will "prescribe" a hitting and fielding regiment for that individual to use not only during the camp, but for afterwards as well.

Each day of hitting will consist of drills, soft toss, and on field batting practice. Each day of fielding will consists of drills, position work, and infield and outfield routine.
