

ENROLLMENT for NICOLET UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

Nicolet Union High School District is an independent district consisting of one school, Nicolet Union High School. For that reason, all incoming students must enroll and provide residency to be accepted into the district. This enrollment process should not be confused with registration, which will take place in July for all Nicolet students.

New student online enrollment takes place **Friday, November 1st through Friday, December 20th**. The first Parent 101 meeting on November 6th covered the topic of enrollment. How to complete online enrollment:

Families of current Nicolet students: Sign into Skyward Family Access and select New Student Online Enrollment.

Families new to Nicolet: Begin the process by going to the Nicolet website (www.nicolet.us). You can find the “Enroll in NUHS” link in the top right-hand corner of the Nicolet website, or you can click [HERE](#). Look under the column “I DO NOT currently have a student enrolled at Nicolet” and follow the steps.
