#### Happy fall everyone!

Welcome back to a new school year! For those that may not know what "FAC" stands for in the PTO, it is our <u>Fund Allocation Committee</u>. This committee is charged each year with spending any funds raised in the prior school year that were above and beyond the amounts pledged for last year's expenditures. Each school has a separate FAC composed of the school principal, two parent representatives, and a teacher representative.

I am thrilled to report that, despite the chaos of the last school year, we have **over \$16,000 in our FAC budget**, which will be divided equally between our two schools. Thank you everyone for making this possible! We will begin the process of distributing these funds by requesting staff to submit grant proposals, which will be reviewed by the FAC for approval. We are in the process of forming the two Fund Allocation Committees, and are looking for parent representatives to serve on both the Stormonth and Bayside committees. These committees meet two or three times per year to review grant proposals. It's not a big time commitment, but it is such an important role to ensure funds raised by our organization are spent fairly and wisely.

Welcome back to the fall semester! We are so grateful that the school is back in person full time and the students and teachers have a safe environment to start the year. Several wonderful PTO sponsored events/programs have happened since the beginning of the fiscal year.

On the fundraising side, the summer Cupcake Color Run (CCR) had a huge turnout and helped raise \$10,928 net profit for the school district. We are thankful for the diligent planning of the CCR committee, the help offered by our cheerful volunteers, the generous contribution of local business sponsors, and the enthusiastic participations of district families. This is truly a wonderful community event that brings everyone together.

# Stormonth Principal Report (by Laura Witkov)

Hello Everyone,

We are so glad to be back in school, and have had a great start to the school year! Stormonth staff would like to thank our amazing PTO for the Cupcake Run, Staff Luncheon in August, and all of the volunteers for our New Family Dinner! We've had wonderful volunteers at lunch and recess at Stormonth to help our students acclimate to the new year.

It has been great to be back in person 5 days per week! Students are enjoying our NEW all-inclusive playground, our new breakfast program, and the opportunity to get back to some normalcy, such as doing "Morning Announcements" over the loudspeaker and attending school on Fridays! We are also offering playground coverage in the mornings before school from 7:30-7:40 am which has been a positive experience thus far.

We are continuing with many Covid-19 mitigation strategies at school to help keep everyone safe. We have universal masking, hand washing, and are maintaining 3 ft of distance between students as much as possible. We've had 31% of our student population participate in weekly asymptomatic covid screening through our vendor Novir. We have 50% who are enrolled in Diagnostic testing (if they are having symptoms or have recently been exposed), 47% have given consent for Outbreak testing, and 40% for Event testing. Students stay in their class cohort at lunchtime, and our motto is "eat and get out to play!" Students attend specials together as cohorts. Please continue to monitor

your child for symptoms at home, and we appreciate your partnership in keeping everyone healthy and safe.

Teachers held Parent Information Night (PIN) on Wednesday, September 22 from 6-8 p.m. with curriculum presentations from each grade level and each specialty area, as well as live "Meet & greet" sessions with each teacher and administration. Conferences will be held virtually on Oct. 14, 15 and 21. Our first STORM rally is scheduled next week on September 30. We will not be holding large group assemblies, so students will be accessing our assembly virtually. Students will be attending field trips as usual. We are looking forward to a wonderful fall!
