Minor Behaviors Reflection Sheet (Teacher managed, given after 2 re-directions)	Major Behaviors Office Discipline Referral (ODR) (Office managed)
<u>Abusive/Inappropriate Language</u> Hurtful and/or inappropriate language not directed at an individual.	<u>Abusive Language/ Inappropriate Language/ Profanity</u> Hurtful, abusive and/or offensive language that is racially charged, purposeful and/or ongoing.
<u>Defiance/Disrespect/ Non-compliance</u> Purposeful failure of student to respond to adult directions or requests.	<u>Defiance/Disrespect/ Insubordination/ Non-Compliance</u> Student engages in refusal to follow directions, talks back and/or delivers socially rude and disrespectful interactions.
<u>Disruption</u> Student engages in interruptive behavior; consistently interrupting, talking with friends, distracting others.	<u>Disruption</u> Student engages in behavior causing a significant disruption so that learning cannot continue. This includes: sustained yelling or screaming; noise with materials; and/or sustained out-of-seat behavior.
<u>Property Misuse</u> Student engages in misuse of property such as, a mess that can be cleaned up or repaired, inappropriate use of classroom supplies.	<u>Property Damage/Vandalism</u> Student participates in an activity that results in destruction or disfigurement of school or individual property.
<u>Lying</u> Student delivers message that is deliberately untrue. Failure to take ownership of their actions.	<u>Lying</u> Student delivers message that is untrue with the intent to harm others.
<u>Technology Violation</u> Student engages in inappropriate (as defined by school) use of technology. (SEE DISTRICT POLICY)	<u>Technology Violation</u> Student engages in inappropriate (as defined by school) use of technology.(SEE DISTRICT POLICY)
<u>Physical Contact/ Physical Aggression</u> Student engages in inappropriate physical contact, but not with the intent to harm.	<u>Physical Aggression</u> Student engages in actions involving serious physical contact with the intent to harm.
	<u>Harassment/Bullying</u> Student delivers disrespectful messages* (verbal or gestural) to another person that includes threats and intimidation, obscene gestures, pictures, or written notes. *Disrespectful messages include negative comments based on race, religion, gender, age, and/or national origin; sustained or intense verbal attacks based on ethnic origin, disabilities or other personal matters.
	<u>Fighting</u> Student is involved in mutual participation in an incident involving physical violence.
	<u>Forgery/Theft</u> Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property or has signed a person's name without that person's permission.
<u>Other</u> Student engages in any other minor problem behaviors that do not fall within the above categories.	<u>Other</u> Student engages in any other major problem behavior that does not fall within the above categories OR receives 3 Reflection Sheets on the same day.
