



## Stormonth Student End of Year Technology Information

June 2025

Dear Stormonth Families,

As we approach the end of the school year, we have several important updates for our student chromebook EOY procedures. Please read these carefully as there are many time sensitive details.

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### If your student is leaving the district:

- **June 11, 2025: All exiting students leaving the district must turn in their chromebook, case, and charger to the front office** in good working condition. Any fees for damages or replacements not covered by Chromecare insurance will be assessed.
- **July 1, 2025: All exiting student district Google accounts will be deleted on July 1, 2025.** If your student would like to keep any of their Google files, please see the [Transfer Google Account Instructions](#) explaining this process.

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### If your student currently has a loaner chromebook:

- **June 11, 2025: Any students with loaner chromebooks must return them to the STORM/ LMC.** Students will not take the loaner chromebook home over the summer. If their device is still out for repairs, families will be notified to pick it up once the device has arrived at the school.

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### If your student is currently in grades 1-4:

- **All students in grades 1- 4 will keep their assigned chromebook, case, and charger over the summer.** Please keep your device in a safe space, stored in its case, and away from opportunities for liquid or pressure damage. *Students are expected to bring their device, fully charged, to the first day of school!*
- ***Incoming 5th grade students*** will turn in their chromebook/charger/case during the first day of school at Bayside. They will then exchange their old chromebook/charger/case from Stormonth for their new assigned chromebook/charger/case to be used throughout 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade.

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**Other Summer Tech Information:**

- **August 1, 2025: All student passwords grades 4th-8th will be updated.** Once passwords are changed, students will no longer be able to access their school chromebook or Google account. All students will receive a new password on the first day of the new school year.
- While students may use their device for summer learning, this is an independent use of district owned technology. There will not be family technical support/ troubleshooting or Chromecare repair tickets and deliveries during the summer months.
- Students are expected to use technology appropriately and with responsible digital citizenship. All students are expected to follow the guidelines listed in the Fox Point- Bayside Student Acceptable Use Policy and school PBIS Technology Matrix.
