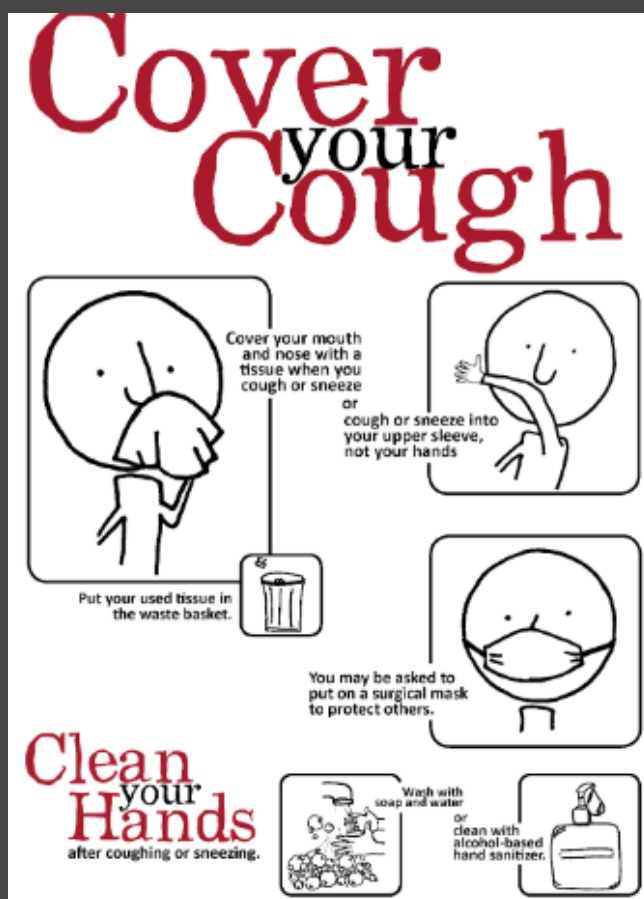

### HAND HYGIENE DURING COLD AND FLU SEASON

## K4 - HALF DAY MODEL

During the January School Board meeting the board took action to recommend our K4 programming return to a half-day format. The past two school years we have piloted a full day option. We are grateful for the work of staff who have made this a positive experience for students. The state currently limits the funding for a K4 student at 60% of what it provides for full-day K5-8th grade students. Expanding our full day program to all interested families would cause a major constraint on district funds and resources. We will continue to advocate to state officials on the value of the K4 experience. Additionally, we are working hard to ensure a quality wrap care experience for K4 families that need support for a full school day.
