DID YOU KNOW?

... That our school uses **Text Messaging** to communicate urgent messages to our parents?

If you would like to opt in to receive Text Messages for School Closings and Urgent Incidents like Buses running late or cancelled, Cancellations of school sponsored events, Athletics or after school activities, Parent Traffic disruptions (construction related), please see these instructions on How to Opt In for Emergency Text Messages.

There are two parts to the process: Text the word "START" to 91201 and make sure your cell number has "Emergency" selected as a contact preference.

WINTER RECESS REMINDERS

We go outside as often as we can! When the weather dips below the mid-50's, we require students to wear a jacket or a heavy sweatshirt.

When the temperature is below 32° a hat and gloves are required.

Snow pants and boots are required for children wishing to play on snowy areas of the playground. Snow pants are also required to be on the grassy area when the snow is melting and things get really soggy.

If it is a consistent rain, or the wind chill is below 10-15 degrees, we will have recess inside.

A medical excuse is required if there is a medical reason that requires your child to stay inside at recess.

Learn more about our district's new Social Emotional Learning Curriculum, RULER, which was developed by the Yale Center for Emotional Intelligence. This session for families is an introduction to what your children are learning at school.

The curriculum focuses on helping parents and caregivers better recognize, understand, accept, and manage their own and their children's emotions. Content will help caregivers feel more comfortable with the full range of human emotions and guide them to deal with those emotions in ways that support the development of warm and secure relationships.

RULER for Families uses everyday language that is approachable and inclusive, such as how to help children to be kind, happy, and confident. Content supports parents and caregivers in being their "best selves," such as patient, responsive, and loving while holding their children to a high standard. RULER for Families was designed to validate and broaden social and emotional skill learning at home, honor cultural diversity, and prepare children for success in life.
