## WINTER RECESS REMINDERS

We go outside as often as we can! When the weather dips below the mid-50's, we require students to wear a jacket or a heavy sweatshirt.

When the temperature is below 32° a hat and gloves are required.

Snow pants and boots are required for children wishing to play on snowy areas of the playground. Snow pants are also required to be on the grassy area when the snow is melting and things get really soggy.

If it is a consistent rain, or the wind chill is below 10-15°, we will have recess inside.

A medical excuse is required if there is a medical reason that requires your child to stay

inside at recess.


#### March 11, 2025, 1:00 pm and 6:00 pm
